## Nepali American Center handovers Earthquake Donation Fund to NRNA

Many of our fellow Nepalese perished from devastating Earthquake of 2015, many were injured and there was loss of many more properties. At such time of natural difficulty, Nepali American Center reached out to fellow Nepalese and friends of Nepal asking for donation to help the victims for immediate relief and reconstruction.



Our records show that many individuals and organizations from Chicagoland area, many more from across USA and some even from European countries trusted NAC and donated for the cause. US senator Dick Durbin and Congresswoman Jan Schakowsky also attended and helped to raise the funds. With overwhelming outpouring of support, NAC was able to raise about \$55,000.

Our donors wanted to use the fund for Earthquake victims through NRNA ICC. Out of the total, NAC used about \$3000 for immediate relief purpose through NRN ground volunteers. It transferred a sum of \$15,000 for intermediate relief plan work to NRNA NCC USA, which was unused to date pending agreement between Nepal Government and NRNA ICC for identifying the reconstruction project. NAC was waiting to transfer the remaining funds to NRNA ICC when the reconstruction project was approved and finalized by the Government of Nepal. NRNA ICC agreed to construct 1000 model houses in the Earthquake hit area of Gorkha district.

We like to inform our donors that NAC vice president Mr. Ramakant Kharel handover remaining fund of \$36,000 by presenting a check to NRNA ICC president Mr. Shesh Ghale during the 9<sup>th</sup> NRNA Regional Conference in New Jersey USA on Saturday August 27, 2016. With that NAC fulfilled its promise to the donors in using the fund via NRNA ICC to help Earthquake victims. NAC is also happy to inform that NRNA ICC will use this fund and all other fund it collected in a transparent manner and with minimum administrative costs.

NAC likes to thank all the donors for their trusts and assures them that the fund is in the hand of our own philanthropic president Mr. Shesh Ghale.
